Kindergarten Gradual Entry

Our Kindergarten students will follow a gradual entry process for their first week at school. Kindergarten students will begin school on Wednesday, September 8th in the afternoon from 1:00 pm until 2:30 pm. On Thursday, September 9th, they will attend in the morning from 8:30am until 12:00 pm. Kindergarten parents will need to arrange transportation for their child to and from school on these two days.
